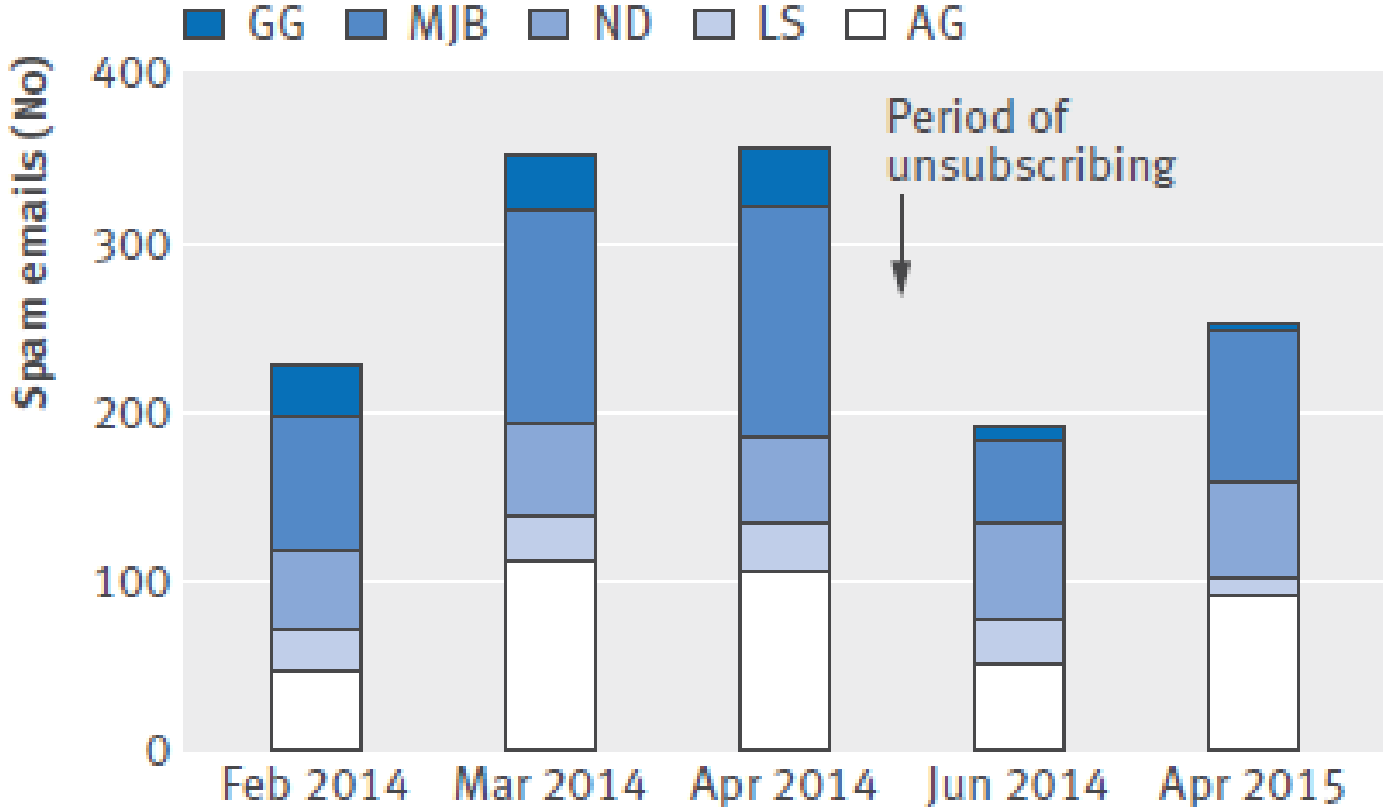

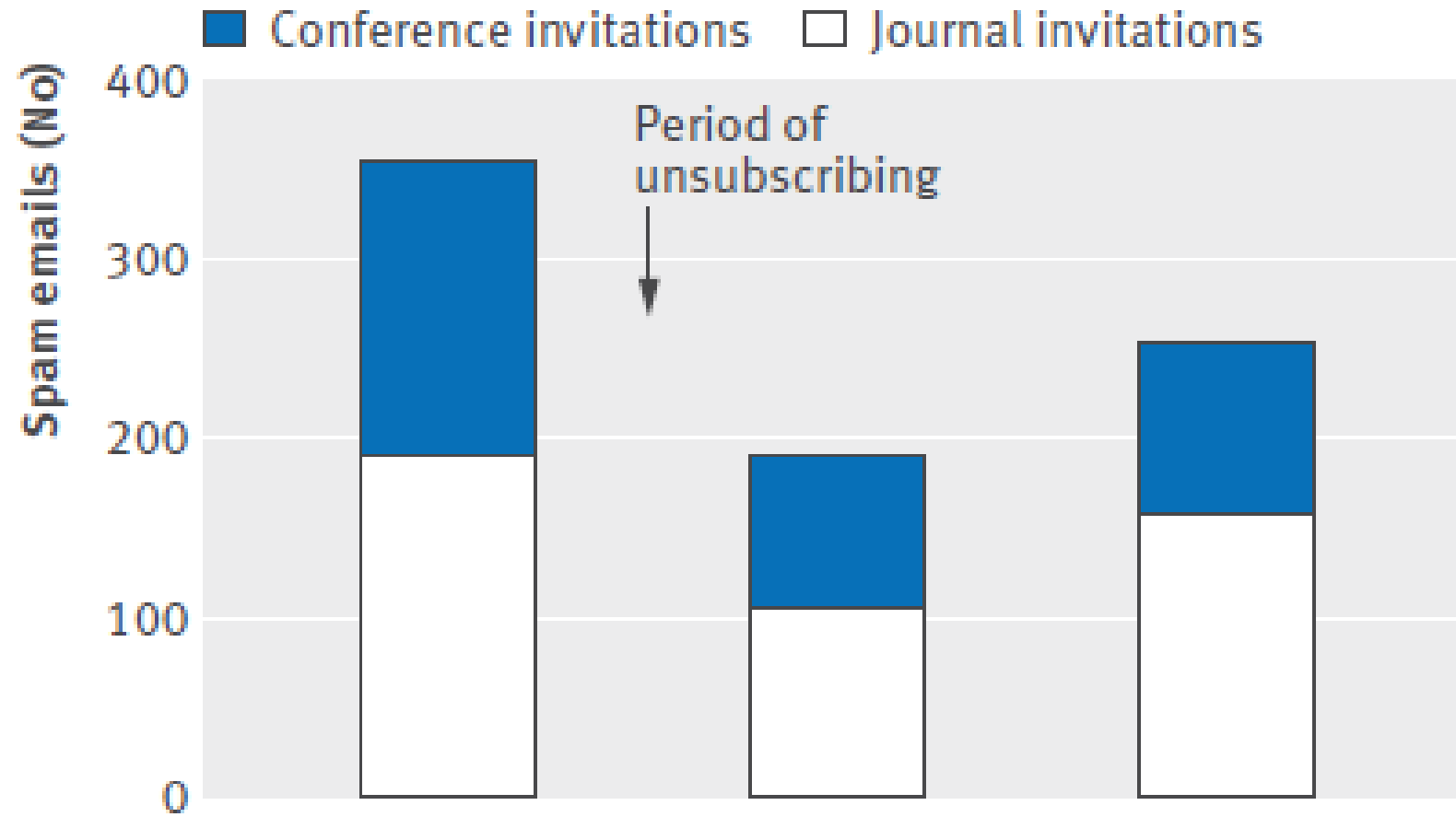

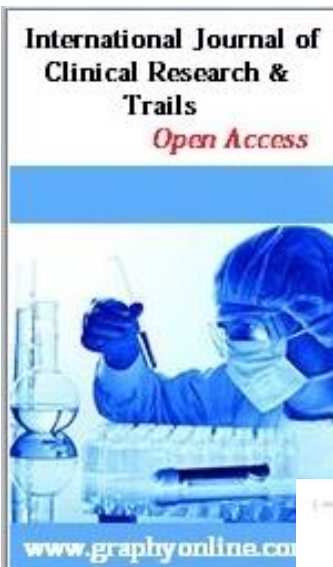
## Fringe Scientist Named Editor-in-Chief of OMICS Astrobiology Journal

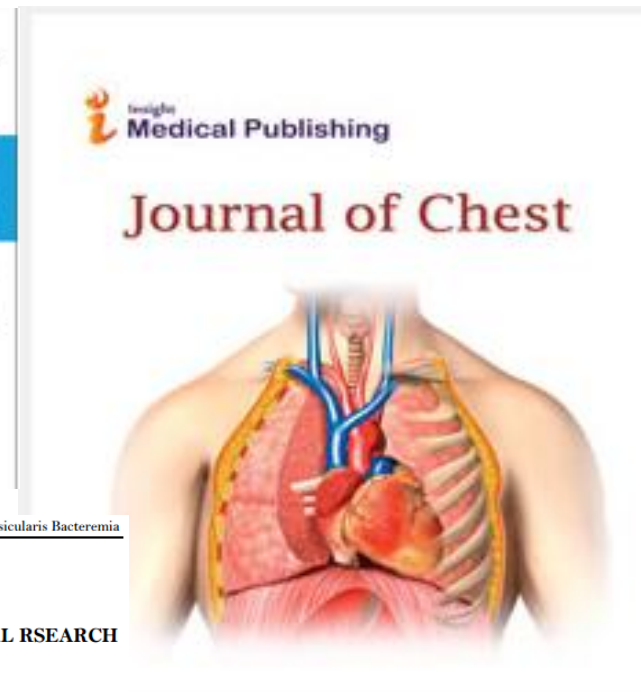

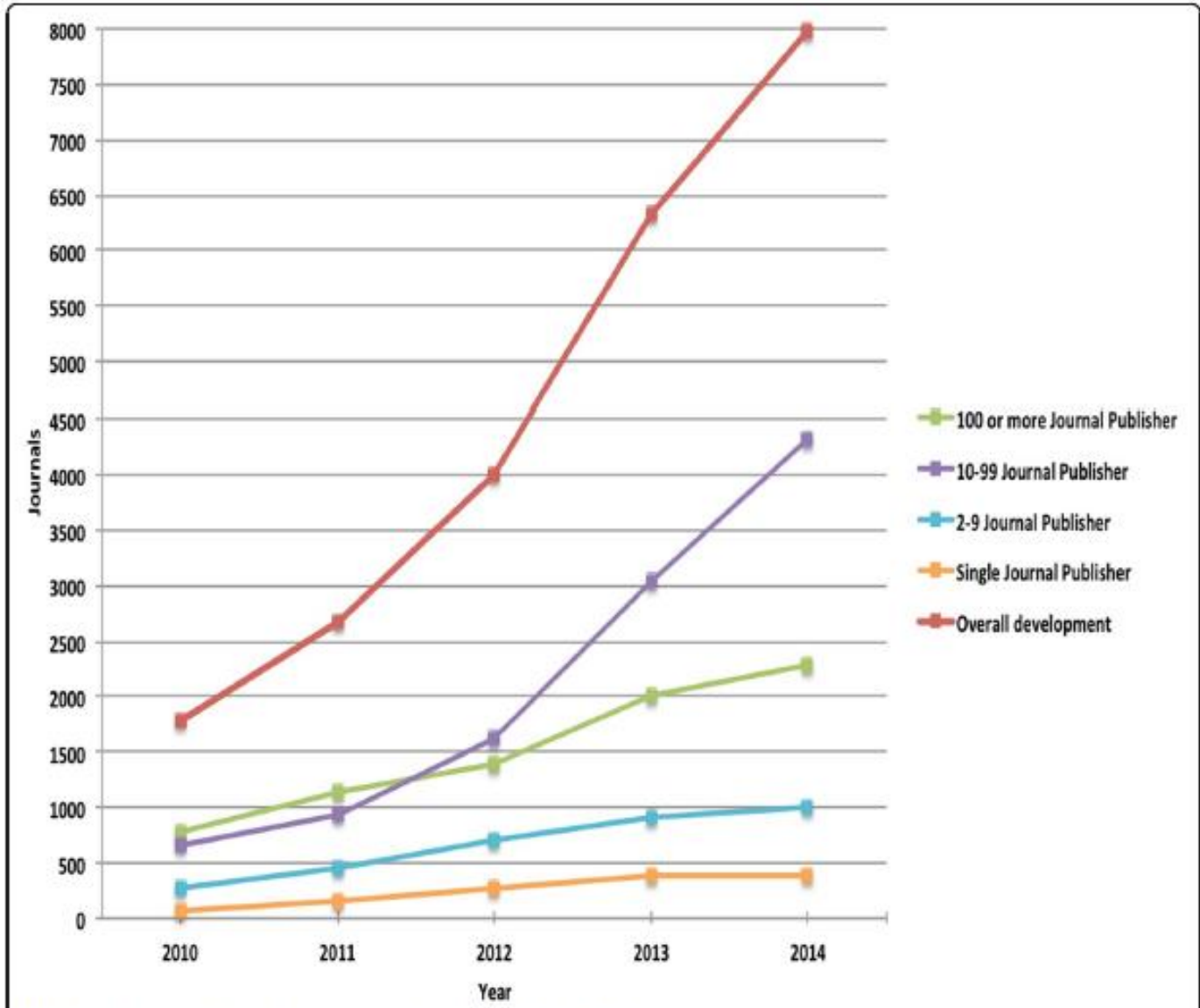


Fig. 2 The development of active predatory open access journals from 2010 to 2014.

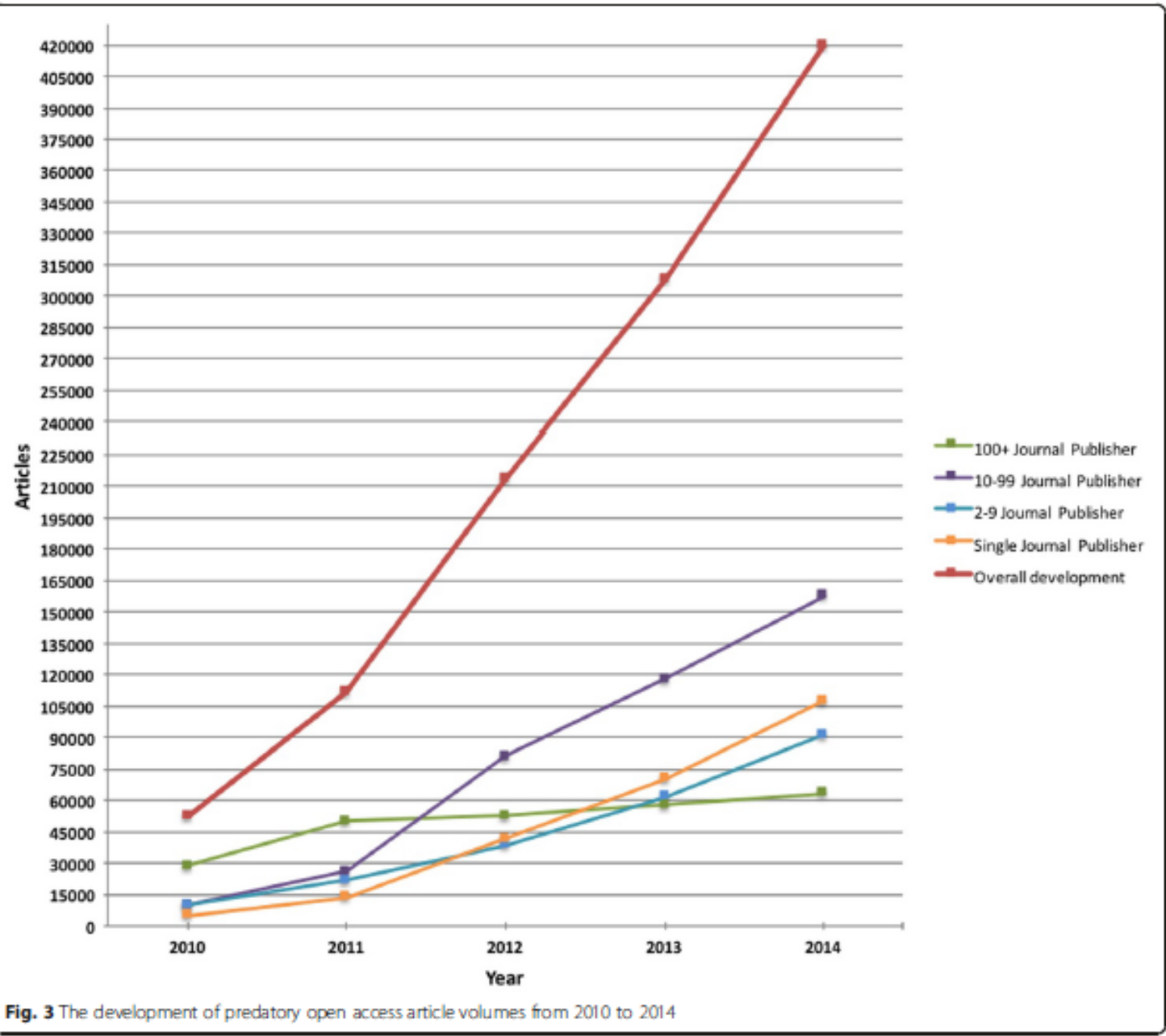
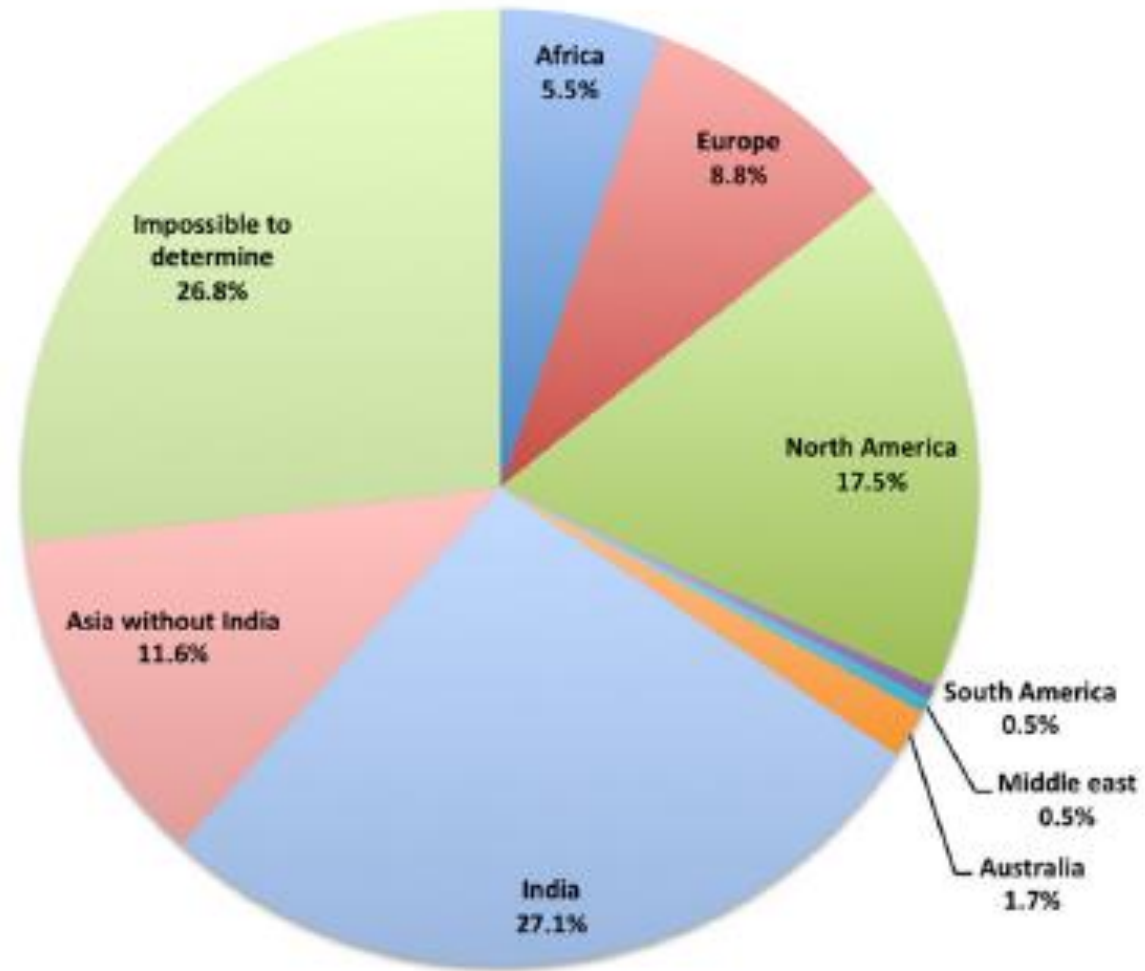
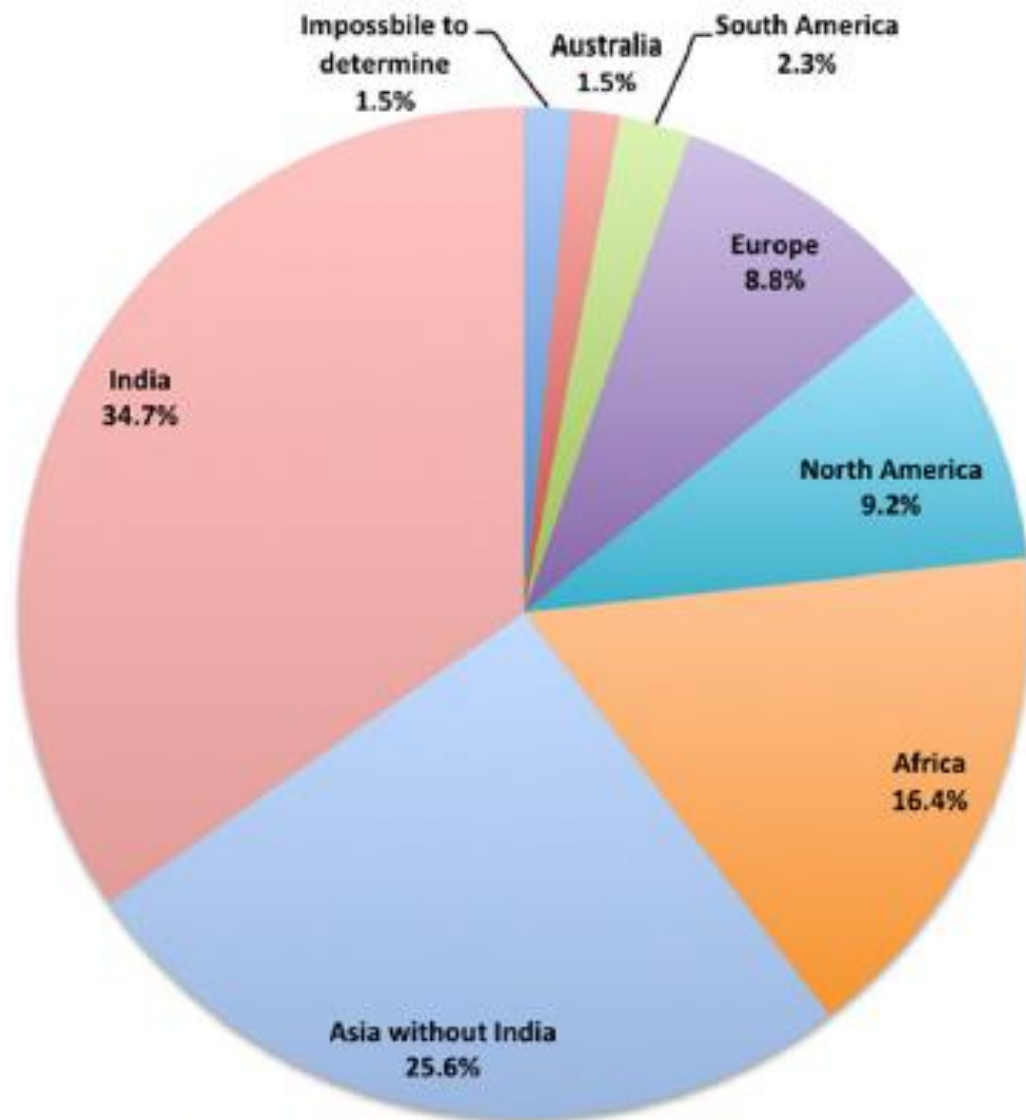


Fig. 3 The development of predatory open access article volumes from 2010 to 2014

J'ai été interrogé par Jeffrey Beall qui tient un registre des revues prédatrices et des revues prises en otage. Il suspectait que la revue Fourrages, publiée par L'Association Française pour la Production Fourragère, avait été piratée, copiée et prise en otage par des prédateurs. A première vue, j'ai eu du mal à voir la

supercherie. J'ai cru, à tort, qu'il s'agissait de la version anglaise de Fourrages, sans que les liens entre les versions françaises et anglaises soient explicites.... Investigation et confirmation : Fourrages a été ajouté le 15 juin 2015 à la liste des [Hijacked Journals](#).

La rédaction de Fourrages a confirmé avoir suspecté cette supercherie depuis quelques semaines. Je n'avais pas vu des choses simples : la rédactrice en chef, Françoise Vertes, est devenue Francoise Green dans la version anglaise ! S'appeler Vertes ou Green est vraiment super pour la revue Fourrages ! Les articles de la version anglaise ne sont pas ceux, traduits, de la version française. Comparez entre la [vraie revue Fourrages](#), et la [revue des pirates](#) (en anglais)... vous serez étonné. La revue pirate, appelée Fourrages aussi, avec les mêmes couleurs, contient beaucoup d'articles.. d'où viennent-ils ?

Que faire ? Fourrages a alerté son hébergeur, mais que peut-il faire ? Rien.. Ils vont écrire aux pirates, mais ce sera difficile. L'objectif des pirates est uniquement de faire un peu d'argent en piégeant des auteurs naïfs qui soumettront des articles qui seront acceptés très vite, après un supposé peer review. Si ces pirates se sentent menacés (situation très rare), ils changent immédiatement leur système, et les identifier est presque impossible.

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
